



Judy Witherdin Glass

I am a glass artist who uses the warm glass method of fusing and slumping to make decorative tableware such as platters and bowls, vases and jewellery with lampworked glass beads. In the last 10 years I have used my fusing skills to begin large scale sculptural pieces formed using steel, mesh and concrete and mosaicing fused glass to form the various designs.

Commenced glass art in Orange under the tuition of Warren Langley (Nurses Memorial Anzac Parade and 'Touching Lightly' Tower at Canberra Glassworks) in 1980. Further studies at Mitchell College of Education (now Charles Sturt University) Bathurst and ANU Glass workshop in Canberra.

Clients since moving to Canberra in 1987 include Merici College, St. Edmunds College, Bernie Fraser, the American Embassy, Cheryl Kernot, Bob McMullen and Dame Quentin Bryce.

Exhibitions include the Australian Craft Show, Design and Giftware Show, Glass Artists Gallery, Glebe, The Australian Crafts Council and Strathnairn Homestead Gallery Canberra.
